- *Caliper Technologies v. Applera*. Obtained \$56 million verdict in favor of client in trade secret misappropriation case. The case was a top 10 verdict in California in 2010 as reported by the California Law Journal.
- *Hamlin v. Zohuri*. Obtained \$400,000 judgment in favor of client in fraud and breach of contract case.
- *McLean v. Volpe, Brown, Whelan Asset Management*. Obtained \$13.5 million verdict in favor of client for fraud and breach of contract including punitive damages. This case was a top 10 verdict in California in 2005 as reported by the California Law Journal.
